The position as Postdoctoral Scientist involves work on studies related to:

- Cancer epidemiology, molecular epidemiology, and cancer prevention
- Genetic variation and GWAS in relation to colorectal cancer
- Biomarkers, including metabolomics, nutrition and inflammation
- Pharmacogenetics
